The St. Louis Symphony Chorus is a world-renowned, 110-voice chorus made up primarily of volunteers from the St. Louis region. Founded in 1976, the Chorus appears on stage at Powell Hall with the SLSO several times each season and performs repertoire from the entire choral-orchestral canon from nineteenth-century favorites to new works by composers of today.
