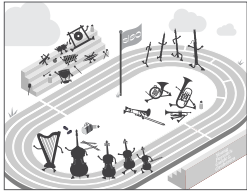


# Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra

## Listening Map

### Description

Below is a two-page Listening Map for *Young Person's Guide to the Orchestra*. On the map, the instruments of the orchestra are depicted as members of a track team participating in a relay race.



**Page 1** corresponds to 7:23-10:07 of the video, where the theme is played first by the whole orchestra, then by each orchestra family: Woodwinds, Brass, Strings, and Percussion.

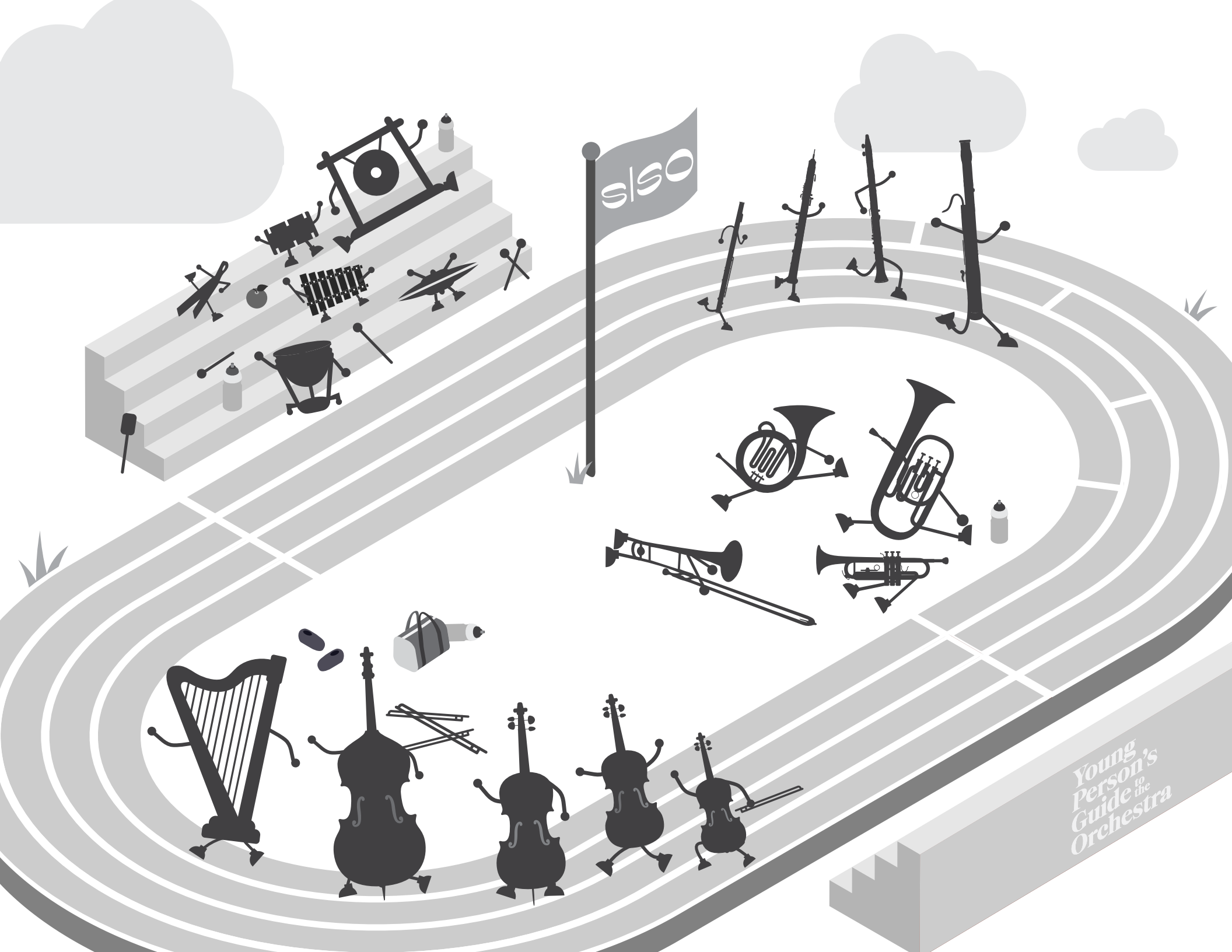
**Page 2** corresponds to 10:07-23:16 of the video, where individual instruments play a succession of variations.

From 23:16 to 26:42, students can follow page 2 again, since the instruments' entrances in the fugue occur in the same order as they did in the variations.



Print the Listening Map and distribute to your students. As students listen to the piece and watch the video, they can use their finger to follow along on the Listening Map. Or they can circle each instrument as it sounds using colors that match the orchestra musicians' shirts.

- Woodwind Family = Green
- Brass Family = Yellow
- String Family = Blue
- Percussion Family = Red
