Founded in the 1976/1977 season, the St. Louis Symphony Chorus is an auditioned ensemble composed mostly of volunteer singers from the St. Louis region. Chorus members come from all walks of life, uniting to create remarkable musical experiences. Appearing with the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra several times each season, the Chorus performs repertoire from the entire choral-orchestral canon. Recognized for its artistic excellence, the Chorus has performed with the SLSO to critical acclaim at Powell Hall, Carnegie Hall, and other venues locally and nationally.
