### **Interview Requests**

For interviews with SLSO musicians or staff please contact the Public Relations Director (contact information above). Interviews with guest artists can also be requested and are subject to the decision of the artist's management.

### **Complimentary Media Tickets**

Complimentary media tickets can be requested through the Public Relations Director (contact information above). The issuance of tickets is at the discretion of the SLSO. Tickets are limited to two per person per concert and are seated where there is availability.

### **Concert/Rehearsal/Event Photography and Videography Guidelines**

- To film a concert, rehearsal, or event, please contact the Public Relations Director (contact information above) in advance. The SLSO reserves the right to disallow entry to events without prior notice of attendance.
- Please arrive with enough time for any required set-up, or at least 10 minutes before the start of an event.
- For photography/videography during concerts, equipment should be self-contained, without lights (battery powered or plugged in), boom mics, or the need to plug into an outlet.\* Additional equipment may be used for other non-concert photography/videography needs, approved by the SLSO with at least 24 hours' notice.
- Concerts may be photographed/filmed from select locations. An SLSO representative will meet media members in advance to show acceptable locations.
- No more than 40 minutes of any concert may be recorded for news media or promotional uses. Audio or audio-visual material recorded must be edited down to no more than five minutes for news or promotional uses. Material used cannot include a complete work or movement longer than three minutes.†
- Please observe appropriate concert etiquette: silence cell phones, move during breaks in the music, and minimize distractions to guests and musicians.

*\*Please notify the SLSO if your setup is not self-contained with at least 24 hours' notice.*

### **Directions and Parking**

Powell Hall is located at 718 North Grand Blvd, St. Louis, MO 63103. Grand Boulevard is accessed off Interstates 64, 44, or 70. I-64 is the closest interstate access.

Free street parking is available around the venue and is the preferred parking method. If you have special parking needs, please contact the Public Relations Director in advance.



Two parking lots serve the immediate area around Powell Hall:

- The Delmar lot (available concert evenings and weekends only), located north of the hall off Delmar Boulevard, and
- The Samuel Shepherd Lot, located along the south and east sides of the hall off of Samuel Shepard Dr.

Please use the Artist and Staff entrance on the east side of the building accessible from the Samuel Shepherd lot and sign-in with security. You will be issued a visitor badge, which should be worn while in the building. The security guard on duty will connect you with your SLSO contact.
