For nearly 150 years, the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra has been a treasured cultural institution, an education leader, and a musical ambassador for the region. The SLSO is committed to engaging with the community and making music accessible to all through live concerts, free events, music education programs, radio broadcasts, and digital content.

In the 2024/25 season, the SLSO made an impact in St. Louis and around the world:

220,000+ people experienced the SLSO live at venues across the region

250+ concerts, free events, and education programs

150+ community partners including universities, houses of worship, social service agencies, nonprofit organizations, and cultural institutions

237,000+ students and 825+ teachers reached by SLSO education programs

Students and teachers in **46 states and 7 countries** connected with SLSO education programs

218,000+ people reached on weekly radio broadcasts on St. Louis Public Radio and Classic 107.3 FM



Did you know? On June 29, the SLSO joined the Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis and the Fabulous Fox for a special fundraiser featuring the orchestra, IN UNISON and Symphony Choruses, and Grammy-winning vocalist BeBe Winans. The concert raised more than \$350,000 for the Urban League's Disaster Relief Fund, supporting tornado recovery in north St. Louis and partner churches in the SLSO's IN UNISON program.
