



ST. LOUIS SYMPHONY IN UNISON PROGRAM IMPACT

Since 1992, the SLSO's multi-faceted IN UNISON program has built far-reaching partnerships between the orchestra and more than 30 local Black churches. The program's key initiatives also include a chorus that performs and preserves music from the African diaspora, and the IN UNISON Academy, which provides scholarship and fellowship opportunities to young musicians pursuing careers in the music industry.

6,000+ students, church partners, choral singers, and audience members participate

90+ IN UNISON Chorus members

8 IN UNISON Young Artists under age 30 received stipends to perform with the chorus and as soloists throughout the region

6 undergraduate students and graduate fellows received scholarships through the IN UNISON Academy

IN UNISON Chorus members performed for IN UNISON Christmas, featuring Take 6; Lift Every Voice, featuring American gospel artist Donald Lawrence; a community concert at Greater Grace Church, featuring guest conductor Dr. Andre Thomas; the SLSO's fifth Annual Juneteenth concert in collaboration with Manchester United Methodist Church; and at the SLSO's benefit concert for tornado relief
